1990 Institute Spring Bud Program

The 1990 Institute initiated the Spring Bud project in 2001, providing funding and guidance to 1,000 impoverished girls in rural Shanxi Province.

The girls were selected from the poorest farming communities.

They all received an elementary education beyond the 4th grade with many continuing on to high school and college.

After 9th grade, 275 girls entered “key high schools” to pursue their studies; 200 enrolled in vocational schools and 525 joined the workforce.

From 2010 to 2015, 173 girls completed their university studies. A few have completed graduate programs and returned to their villages to share their knowledge.



Mrs. Roz Koo

Mrs. Roz Koo is one of the founding directors of the 1990 Institute. Her vision, leadership, perseverance and passion for women's education enabled this group of young girls to find their way in the world through a better education.

She traveled to the mountain region of Shanxi Province in search of these girls. She hoped that one day they would return home and become leaders in their community. Many have benefitted from her guidance. They all respectfully call her "Grandma Koo."

1990 Institute also funded 20 fellowships for the girls to spend time in their Villages and pay it forward. Here are some of their stories.

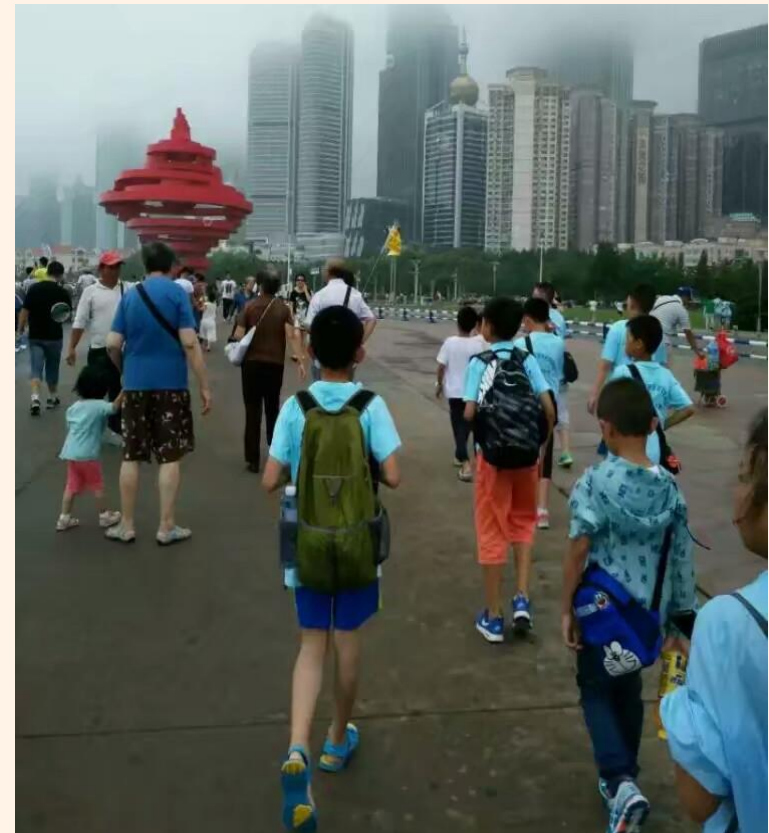

Changes in Rural Education

- **Rural education is improving. Currently, all children have 9 years of free compulsory education, including free textbooks. All children have a chance to learn.**
- **The policy now is to fund and support education with emphasis on child development and teacher training. Training resources are also improved. The “Special Post Teacher Policy” has been implemented to elevate the overall quality of rural teachers and to ensure a higher quality of rural education. This is an attempt to reduce the gap between city and village education standards.**
- **Government and philanthropic organizations are joining forces to invest in the farming communities, increase farming income, improve the environment, and subsidize medical expenses and education. For the very poor living in rural areas, there can be 100% government support to ensure that they receive a solid and sound education.**

- The “Egg Milk Project” provides free nutritious food to students and enables them to stay healthy in school.
- With improvements in China’s living standards, many more families now have the means to help their children acquire an education and secure a better future for the next generation.
